

SCHUBERTLINE GIFT TOKEN

SIX MONTH SUBSCRIPTION

This Gift Token entitles the holder to a free six month subscription commencing on the date of validation, and expiring at the end of the 6th month following the month of validation.

To activate the Subscription, this token must be validated by selecting the 'Validate' link on the Schubertline website Home Page:

When the token has been validated, the subscription will entitle the user to unlimited free printing, in any key, of more than 2200 classical songs, duets and arias available on the Schubertline website.

CONDITIONS OF USE

1. Each token had a unique number. This can only be validated once. This number is NOT the same as the subscription number or password which will be issued after validation.
2. The token may be validated at any time within 12 months of the date of issue.
3. Gift Token subscriptions can only be used to print online scores from the Schubertline website. They cannot be used to purchase CDs or other Schubertline products.
4. Gift Token subscriptions may be used to follow an existing, current subscription, but the Gift Token subscription will be valid for 6 months from the date of validation rather than from the expiry date of the existing subscription. To use a Gift Token subscription in this way, users should delay validation until their current subscription has expired.
5. The Schubertline website requires the use of Sibelius Scorch, the free software for downloading and printing musical scores from the internet. This software must be installed before the subscription is first used to download music. If you already have Scorch installed on your computer, there is no need to re-install it in order to use your subscription.
6. Scorch installs automatically on Windows (using Internet Explorer) the first time a Schubertline score is selected for viewing. For installation on other systems and browsers, please select one of the Scorch download links on the Schubertline website.
